German for Travelers/ German I (GFT/GI)

Instructor: Linda Killingsworth

A course combining survival language skills, culture, customs, and practical advice for the traveler, new resident, or businessperson in Austria, Germany, Switzerland, or other German speaking environment. Suitable for either beginning or intermediate level students, with many handouts both of language and practical materials. Tuesdays, June 2– July 7, 6:00 – 8.30 pm.

German II - German III (GII/III)

Instructor: Sarah-Lena Hassler

A course at intermediate/ advanced level with emphasis on comprehension through practical situations, traveling in German speaking countries, social customs, and contemporary issues. Again, emphasis is on conversation, but there will be more encouragement of reading than in German I. Tuesdays, June 2 – July 7, 6:00 – 8.30 pm.

Fee per course is **\$120**, plus modest materials fee (no textbooks in summer).

Maximum enrollment per class is 12 students. *TGLS reserves the right to cancel a class, in the rare case that enrollment is too low. Deposits would then be refunded.*
